Summary	• Direct radio traffic between rovers, ARES operators deployed at info booths and Shadows. • Perform periodical health and welfare checks.
Assigned Area	• Sunnyvale MEOC, McKinley between Taaffe and Murphy
Reporting Issues	• Life threat: call 9-1-1. • Other police/fire/medical issue: report to IC if present in the MEOC, otherwise go to “IC Shadow”. • Other event-related issue: go to “Laura Shadow.”
Evacuations	Stay in MEOC and follow instructions from DPS officers.
Radio Issues	If the repeater is unusable because someone has a stuck mic: • Move to the backup frequency. • Take a roll call there to narrow down the operator with an open mic. If there is interference on the repeater: • Switch to the backup frequency.
Additional Information	• The radios in the MEOC are Yaesu FT-7900. You might want to check out the manual ahead of time. The channels are already programmed. • HTs will not work inside the MEOC.
